Thank you for your trust, and we wish you lots of fun at the sea! In this note, we would like to share some practical information.

- Address of the residence: Albert-I-Promenade 6, residence Le Touquet, 4<sup>th</sup> floor, apartment B. The brown door on the left when you exit the elevator. You will see our names (Daniëls - Clerinx) on the doorbell.
- We have provided a key safe in our letterbox in the entrance hall of the residence to facilitate checking in and out. The key set in the safe contains a key (with a blue ball) for the door downstairs in the entrance hall and a key for the apartment door (shaped like a fish tail). All windows are equipped with locks, which can be used if, for example, small children are present. For this, you can use the smallest key. Another key provides access to our private cellar. Don't forget your keys when you leave the apartment. After your stay, the key set should be returned to the key safe (unless otherwise agreed).
- The elevator has a sensor over the entire height of the door. As soon as something passes in front of the sensor, the elevator will immediately stop. This is, of course, for safety reasons and to prevent anything from getting stuck. If the elevator stops or blocks, you need to press the button for a different floor, and the elevator will then continue its way. Note: after three consecutive sensor stops, the elevator goes into safety mode, and a technician must be called via the emergency service.
- The heating works with a central thermostat in the living room. First, set the thermostat to the desired temperature, then open the radiators where needed.
- You can turn the fridge and freezer on and off with the rotary knob in the fridge. When checking out, please turn off the appliance and leave both doors slightly open.
- Pillows and duvets are provided in the two bedrooms. There are two double duvets (180 cm x 200 cm) and two single duvets (90 cm x 200 cm). You must provide your own fitted sheets, duvet covers, and pillowcases. It is also useful to bring a dishcloth, kitchen towel, toilet paper, and possibly a tablecloth.
- There are some cabinets with a lock. Our personal belongings are behind these.

- For waste disposal, please use the waste collection point at Montgomerykaai. This is easily accessible on foot (200 meters from the entrance of the residence). You will find a glass container, a container for paper and cardboard, a container for PMD, and a container for residual waste. Everyone can use these waste containers. The residual waste container is paid, and you can deposit your waste in it by inserting a coin of 50 euro cents (for about 25 liters of waste / no regular garbage bag required).
